

Appendix 1: Membership Rules and Additional Information

1. Only individuals who have purchased a 2014 membership with the Liberal Party of Canada (“LPC”) are eligible to vote at the above Founding Meeting. An annual LPC membership costs only \$10.
2. The cut-off deadline to become a paid LPC member eligible to vote at the Founding Meeting is 7 days prior to the meeting date at 5:00 PM (i.e.: 5:00 PM on Saturday, February 1, 2014), unless an individual falls into one of the categories described in the next two paragraphs.
3. Individuals whose LPC membership expired on December 31, 2013 may renew their membership on any day up to the day of the meeting, and may renew at the door of the Founding Meeting up to 5 minutes prior to the start time of the meeting and still be eligible to vote at the above Founding Meeting.
4. Victory Fund and Laurier Club donors who are not already members of the Liberal Party of Canada may purchase a membership on any day up to the day of the meeting, and may purchase a membership at the door of the Founding Meeting up to 5 minutes prior to the start time of the meeting, and still be eligible to vote at the Founding Meeting.
5. Individuals who wish to purchase a 2014 LPC membership online should do so by visiting <https://action.liberal.ca/en/membership> at least seven days in advance of the Founding Meeting. Alternatively, individuals wishing to submit a paper membership form and payment by postal mail are encouraged to submit their membership form to the Liberal Party of Canada (Saskatchewan) (“LPC-SK”) office no later than 14 days prior to the above Founding Meeting. The LPC-SK office is located at **845-A McDonald Street, Regina, Saskatchewan, S4N 2X5**.
6. You must prove your identity and your address in order to vote at the Founding Meeting, for which there are three options:
 - a. Provide one original piece of identification issued by a government or government agency containing, your name and your address (e.g. Drivers Licence) OR
 - b. Provide two original pieces of identification issued by a government, government agency, educational institute, municipal office/agency, public utility or Credit Card Company that provide your name. At least one of these documents must also contain your address: (e.g. Health Card and Hydro Bill) (e.g. Fishing Licence and a Credit card statement) (Student ID card and a School Report card) OR
 - c. Provide one piece of original identification issued by a government, government agency, educational institute, municipal office/agency, public utility or credit card company that provides your name AND swear an oath and be vouched for by a qualified voter in the electoral district who has identification acceptable under a) or b) above.
7. To become a member of the above electoral district association, you must be a resident of the same electoral district pursuant to geographical electoral districts created pursuant to the Canada Elections Act and the Representation Order currently in force thereunder. Alternatively, to become an associate member of the above electoral district association, you must be a resident of Saskatchewan and a LPC member, and pay a supplemental fee of \$5 to the above electoral district association.
8. All members of the above electoral district association must also:
 - a. be at least fourteen (14) years of age;
 - b. support the purposes of the Party;
 - c. not be a member of any other federal political party in Canada;
 - d. not be qualified to vote in any other federal constituency association;
 - e. while a member of the Party, have not publicly declared an intention to be a candidate for election to the House of Commons other than as a candidate of the Party.
