

Appendix II: Nomination and Election of Officers of the Electoral District Association

1. Any individual who holds a valid membership in the relevant riding association may stand for election at the Founding Meeting for any of the following executive positions:
 - a. President;
 - b. Up to two (2) Vice-Presidents (one of whom may be designated as the Executive Vice-President);
 - c. Membership Chair;
 - d. Election Readiness Chair;
 - e. Fundraising Chair;
 - f. Communications Chair;
 - g. Data Management Chair;
 - h. Policy Chair
 - i. Women's Representative;
 - j. Youth Representative;
 - k. Aboriginal Representative;
 - l. Seniors' Representative;
 - m. Treasurer; and
 - n. Secretary

1. Individuals seeking election to any of the above position must file a written Notice of Intent to Stand for Election (see **Form 1**) by the cut-off date (at least 7 days in advance of the meeting).¹
2. Any of the above positions for which two or more individuals have been properly nominated prior to the cut-off date will be filled by the individual who receives the most votes in a secret ballot held at the Founding Meeting.
3. Any of the above positions for which only one individual is properly nominated prior to the cut-off date will be filled by that individual on an uncontested basis and without a vote being held at the Founding Meeting.
4. In respect of any of the above positions, if no candidate is properly nominated prior to the cut-off date, that position may be filled (or be subject to an election by secret ballot) based on nomination of an individual(s) holding a current membership with the LPC and properly nominated from the floor at the Founding Meeting.

¹ A Notice of Intent to Stand for Election shall be submitted in writing to LPC-SK indicating the specific position for which the candidate wishes to stand and the names and contact information for his or her Nominator and Second, both of whom must hold a current LPC membership or current associate membership in the same electoral district association at the time of the filing of the notice. Applicants must hold a valid membership in the relevant electoral district and may not file a Notice of Intent to Stand for Election for more than one position.
